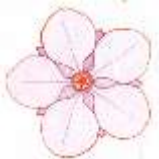


	JANUBI MOTIF	MOTIF INSPIRED BY	JANUBI STYLIZATION	ISLAMIC LINE DESIGN
	PROTITEN	King Protea (SA flora)	a protea with 10 petals	Q33.35 – the ten qualities to which men and women should aspire
	PENTADEN	Adenandra Uniflora (SA flora)	5 petal flower	5 Pillars of Islam, 5 daily prayers
	STRALIFOR	Strelitzia (SA flora)	Spathe with four petals	Like the 2 nd to 5 th pillars of Islam depend on the strength of the 1 st pillar, the declaration of faith, so do the four petals depend on the spathe for emergence and existence.
	PROTIPIN	Pin Cushion Protea (SA flora)	the ‘pin’ stalk, and the 2 nd stalk that adjoins with its 4 petals	The pin stands strong as support for the 4 petals, as does the declaration of Faith for the 4 subsequent pillars of Islam

	TRIMORAEA	Morea flower (SA flora)	6 petals or 2 x 3 petals	to remind us of the 6 tenets of faith in Islam, or <i>2 x Tri-nis (Theme)</i>
	OBIDROP	a water drop	moving in all directions not only downward	spreading mercy
	NIDIPIN	Gnidia Pinifolia (SA Flora)	8 petals Multiples of 4	Gratitude for 4 seasons to value time, and 4 directions, to appreciate orientation and space.
	MOUNTAIN- FOLD	folding mountains in Cape Town (Table Mountain and 12 Apostles)	up-down pattern, <i>overlap-</i> ping peaks	sharing space to survive, supporting background for motifs
